- d) 4

(All the options will be considered correct here. Therefore everyone will get 1 mark irrespective of the answer).

3) Which of the following industries use limestone as raw material?

- a) Cement
- b) Jute
- c) Steel
- d) Sugar

(Answers (a) and (c) will be considered correct).

4) 12 people at a party shake hands once with everyone else in the room. How many handshakes took place?

- a) 64
- b) 66
- c) 74
- d) 76


(Answer (b) will be considered correct).

5) It ----- raining since morning when you rang up.

- a) Had Been
- b) Has Been
- c) Have Been
- d) Having Been

(Answer (b) will be considered correct)
